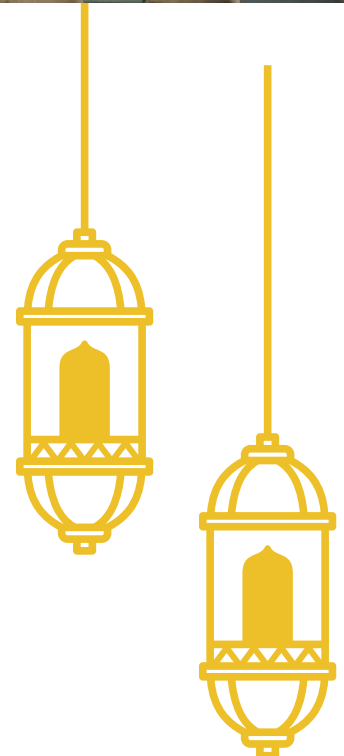
Students of grade 12 conducted an event on Eid Celebrations and the group presented all facts about the holy month of Ramadan and the festive Eid occasion.
